It seems strange to us to-day, that a game so universally popular and of such ancient lineage as Gowf should have so few devotees fifty or sixty years ago. The probable cause was the fact that all the first courses were on the sea-side sandy links of certain favoured districts."

Be that as it may, it was realised by the late 1880's that the game could be played and enjoyed on almost any type of terrain where finding the ball was possible. Golf clubs sprang up almost overnight like mushrooms and a player with his clubs became quite a common sight and was no longer considered an "eccentric with an amiable weakness".

Gourock would not and did not withstand the contagion which swept the whole of Scotland, and following a public meeting on 28th of April 1896 Gourock Golf Club was formed by the 22 gentlemen present.

J.E Turner Hon President of Gourock Golf Club, appeared in "Gourock Times" on 1st November 1946 the Jubilee
