



GOUROCK GOLF CLUB **Junior Section 2019 Guide**

Junior Hours

- These are at all times but booking on the club's BRS System and authorisation from the Starter is essential. Probably best not to play on competition days mainly Monday mornings, Wednesdays until 6pm and Saturdays until 3:30pm although other competitions can impact on other days.

How to Book a Tee Time

- Download the BRS app and register. This then allows you to book a tee time. Ask at the PRO shop or Club Office if you are unclear.

Junior Catering and Menu

- There is a junior menu which is competitively priced. Junior catering follows club catering hours and these are notified each week on the Tuesday newsletter.

Use of Development Studio

- Only 1 hour per day can be booked in advance but if the studio is quiet and after agreeing with the PRO shop your time can be extended on the day. It is free to use but if an adult is playing with you then he/ she needs to pay.

Junior Locker Room

- The noticeboards in your locker room contains various useful pieces of information e.g. details of open competitions, competition results, invitations from other clubs and club competitions. You will have been allocated a locker.
- Please make sure your locker is secure and is looked after – do not leave shoes, clothes or equipment about the locker room
- Please make sure we all keep the Junior locker room tidy at all times

Junior Medals

- They commence at 3:30pm until 5:30pm each Thursday and Saturday.
- You will be allocated a recommended “course”. This comprises the following.
 - Teeing off the yellow tees
 - Teeing off the red tees
 - Teeing off the blue tees
 - Playing the new zig zag course

The above are in multiples of nine or eighteen as chosen by you.
There are score cards for all courses

Hopefully as the 2019 season progresses you will move through this pathway

Golf Rules and Etiquette

- Preliminary rules are in new junior welcome packs.
- Special short tutorials will be held to guide you.

Playing in Open Competitions and Team Matches

- These are open to all able young golfers.
- Depending on your handicap/ability/availability you can be chosen to represent the club.

Keep an eye out for notice in the Junior Locker room

Playing in Club Competitions

- This is open to all and details will be posted on the website and posters in the junior locker room

WhatsApp

- If you join the junior group this will give you access to other young golfers and will assist in your “buddying up”

Score Cards

- Completed and signed score cards should be returned to the score box in the junior locker room.

This will enable you to both gain an official handicap and then work to reduce that as the 2019 season progresses

Safety

- Your safety is paramount
- If you find yourself threatened or intimidated by other members – walk away and report the matter to the club.
- Similarly if this happens when non-members are on the course – walk away and report.
- Also see golf etiquette for safety when playing.
